

SNOW REMOVAL BEGINS AT 8:00 AM. UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTIFIED

Under normal circumstances (no equipment failure, manpower shortage, excess depth of snow) snow removal throughout the City is complete at approximately 6:00 PM.

PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO HAVE YOUR VEHICLE(S) MOVED. ONCE THE SNOW HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM YOUR BLOCK, IF IT IS PARKED ON ANOTHER STREET, PLEASE MOVE YOUR VEHICLE BACK DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE AT ITS MOVED LOCATION - IT MAY BE TOWED.

POSTED RESIDENTIAL AREAS The City will plow Wiswall Avenue, Ball Place and Grotto Court the day before the declared snow emergency. There will be NO PARKING signs posted on these streets the day before informing residents and visitors to move their vehicles.

SECTION ONE (1) North of 19th Street to 26th Street Starts on 3rd Ave. at 26th Street and proceeds South to 19th Street then West to City line. After the Avenues are plowed removal will start on the Streets beginning at 21st Street and continuing to 26th Street. Snow removal on Broadway from 25th Street to 16th Street after the above areas are complete.

SECTION TWO WILL BEGIN WHEN SECTION ONE IS COMPLETE

SECTION TWO (2) South of 19th Street to 10th Street Starts on 3rd Ave. at 19th Street and proceeds South to 10th Street then West to City line. After the Avenues are plowed removal will start on the Streets beginning at 10th Street and continuing to 19th Street. 1st Avenue from 15th Street to the Arsenal wall and Broadway South from 16th Street to the Arsenal Main Gate areas will begin when the above is complete.

SECTION THREE (3) Port Schuyler Area-9th Street to 1st Street SNOW REMOVAL WILL BEGIN AT 8:00 AM Starts at Broadway South of the Arsenal Main Gate and proceeds South to 1st Street then from 9th Street north to 1st Street.

WHAT IS A DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCY?

Within 48 hours after a snow storm of 4" to 6" or more accumulated inches has fallen the City may declare a snow emergency. During the storm the City's attention will be focused on keeping roadways passable. Some streets will be cleared to the curb when there is no vehicle present. **This does not mean that vehicles do not have to be moved if an emergency is declared.**

NOTIFICATION

The local television stations will be advised. You can also learn if there is a snow emergency by visiting our website, www.watervliet.com, by signing up for NIXLE emergency alerts (see below) or by calling 270-3823 where there will be a pre-recorded message alerting residents of the snow emergency and any updates.

The City has an emergency notification system that collects phone numbers of residents. This call list will enable the City to automatically notify residents via texts, calls and/or emails to inform them when there is a declared emergency. WHAT TAKES PLACE AND WHERE DO YOU GO?

An official City vehicle will precede the plows advising residents to move their vehicles or they will be towed. If your vehicle is not moved immediately, the City will tow your vehicle at your expense. To retrieve your vehicle you must pay applicable fines and fees (\$300) to the Finance Department at City Hall, 2 - 15th Street.

Only the registered owner may retrieve the vehicle and no vehicle(s) will be released until the fine is paid. If a vehicle remains in the custody of the City for 14 or more days, a storage fee of \$30 per each day the vehicle is left will be charged.

POSTED BUSINESS AREAS

Business areas (19th Street; 2nd Avenue - between 13th and 26th Streets; and 3rd Avenue in Port Schuyler) will be posted snow removal areas and will be plowed curb to curb the day after the declared emergency areas are complete.

These areas will be posted with NO PARKING signs (between a 4 hour period each side) on the day prior to snow removal.

South of 19th street to 10th street

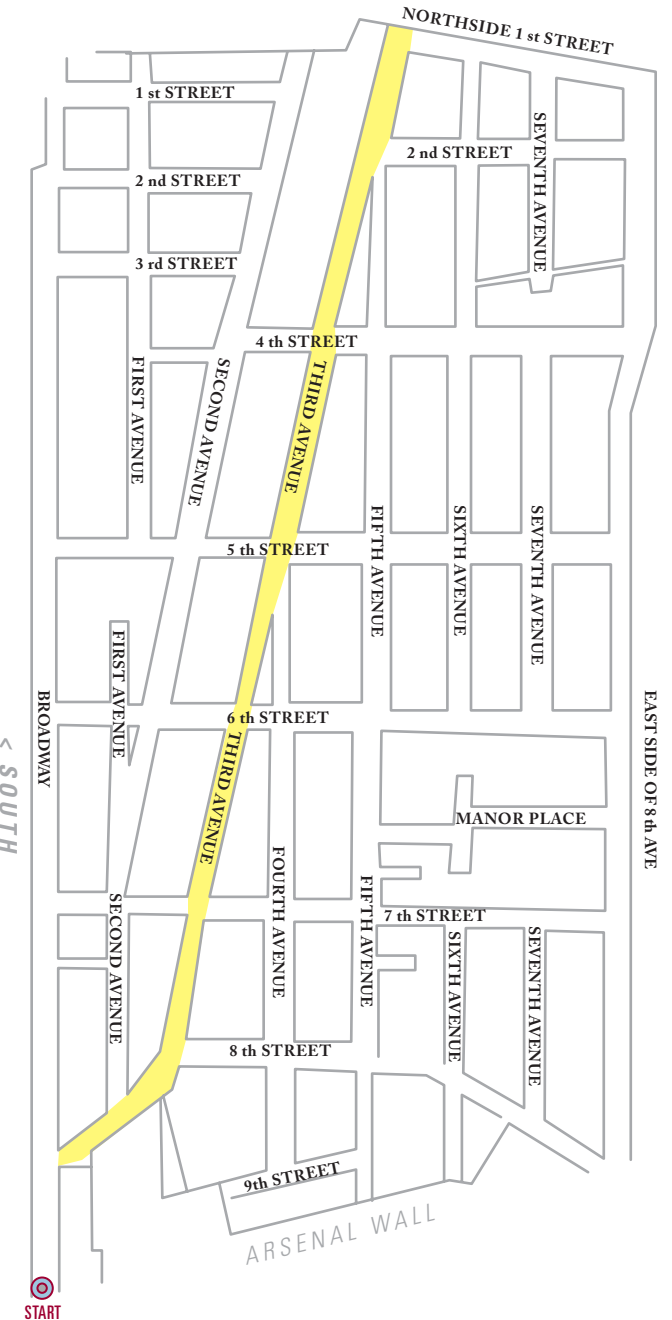
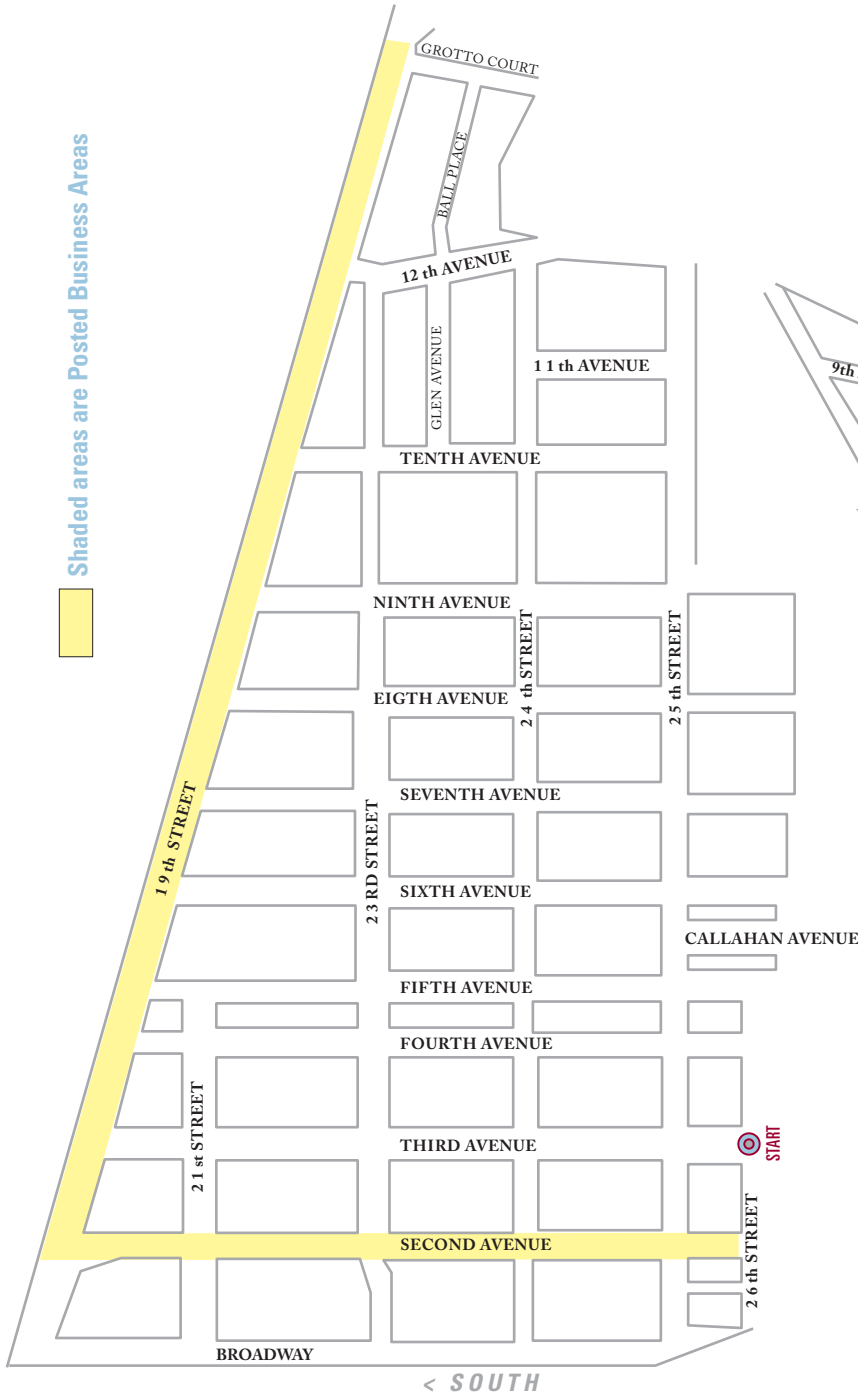
Snow removal, under normal conditions, will be approximately 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM
